## Stewardship Agreement

### In-Parish School Tuition

I/We understand that children of families who are registered St. John parishioners are given priority admission as well as an opportunity to pay tuition at the suggested in-parish rates for students enrolled in Kindergarten through Grade 8. I am aware that the school is the largest ministry of St. John the Evangelist Parish and that the parish gives financial support to the school in order to keep the school accessible to all parishioners.

#### Eligibility to Pay School Tuition at the Suggested In-Parish Rate

Being an active member of the parish means contributing financially, participating in Sunday Mass as you are able, and sharing your talents with the greater community in order to build and sustain an active and vibrant faith community.

St. John Parish offers many ways to participate and be active in the faith community. These range from individual contemplative prayer activities to working on various service projects to being an active participant in the Mass as a lector, usher, or Eucharistic Minister. The foundation of our faith is the Mass, so it is important both for the greater community as well as for our personal faith that we try our best to be regular Mass participants.

In order to be eligible for, and remain eligible to pay tuition at the suggested in-parish rate each family must meet the following criteria:

- Be registered in the parish - you may do this at the parish office or online at [www.stjohnsea.org](http://www.stjohnsea.org)
- Be active in the life of the parish including:
  - Attend Sunday Mass as you are able
  - [View the annual State of the Parish presentation video](#)
  - Be supportive of or involved in one of the many ministries of the parish (usher, choir, lector, commissions, committees, etc.)
  - Contribute regularly (weekly or monthly) through the Sunday envelope or online via VANCO
  - File a new stewardship pledge card with the parish office if you are a new family or you have changed your pledge amount – otherwise your pledge will automatically rollover from 2022
  - Make a consistent effort to meet that pledge
