The price for six weeks of ski bus and lessons is \$575. A bus only option is available for 6 – 8 graders for \$300. LTD Seasons passes will required and offered through the Ski School until December 15, 2023.

Details:

- 8:15am Gear should be dropped at portable with your child at arrival at school. Parents should also include an additional lunch/snacks for kids to eat on the bus.
- 3:00pm Chaperones help kids get gear from portable and load onto buses
- 3:15 Bus departs; we will watch age appropriate movies on the bus. There is a bathroom available. Kids can eat snacks in preparation to ski!
- 4:30 Bus arrives at Summit and chaperones escort kids in lessons to the instructors.
- 4:30 – 7:00 Ski lessons; Grades 6 – 8 free ski
- 7:00 – 7:15 Chaperones escort kids back to bus; leave Summit; eat more snacks
- 8:30-8:45 Arrive back at St John – parents will be notified via group email with an ETA on bus arrival
- Note: *Grades 4-8: Basketball practices may conflict with Thursday night ski schedule. Students participating in Middle School Musical are required to be at all Thursday rehearsals in February.*

Chaperone Info:

- We will take 4 St John parents each week as chaperones who will receive a free lift ticket for helping.
- You do NOT have to be able to ski to chaperone.
- Chaperones will be assigned a group of 5/6 kids to help gather gear and escort to and from the bus. Chaperones are free until lessons are finished at 7pm.
- If you would like to chaperone you can sign up on the registration form or via Sign up Genius one registration closes.

Rental Information:

- Boot and Ski rentals vary from \$150 - \$200 for the season. If you choose to rent for the season you will want to secure gear before December 15th, 2023.
